

HINDI CLASS DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES:

Elementary Hindi: First Level of HINDI CLASS:

We provide in the first year is speaking and a little writing of alphabets.

Our primary objective is to develop speaking and listening proficiency through a variety of daily use situational, and interactive exercises.

We like to make them comfortable in class and feel free to say whatever they know and can say in Hindi or mixture of Hindi and English words in sentence form.

We start with Greeting, name and their liking in daily life.

We will learn few alphabets and some Hindi words or colors or numbers or body parts etc. in each class.

-Recognition and pronunciation of Alphabets.

Attendance: Students are expected to attend most of the classes if student cannot make it then call a classmate / teacher and find out the lesson plan.

Homework: Normally will be giving homework assignment each class.

Quizzes: To make class interesting we will have some small quizzes with rewards.

HINDI CLASS DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES:

Second Level of HINDI CLASS:

Elementary Hindi is consisting of two components:

Grammar, Reading and Writing: This component of the course is the fundamentals of Hindi grammar and basic vocabulary.

Our primary objective is to begin speaking in Hindi as soon as possible.

Conversation: We will participate in interactive speaking and listening drill, aimed at developing basic oral competency in spoken Hindi. We will take full advantage of surroundings.

Students will learn the Hindi reading writing within the first few months of class.

Attendance: Students are expected to attend most of the classes if student can not make it then call a classmate / teacher and find out the lesson plan.

Homework: Normally will be giving homework assignment each class. **Since language learning depends on the continuous accumulation of vocabulary and grammar, we will like to have some parents input.**

Please ask your child what did he /she learn in the class and try to speak to them in HINDI so they can remember and repetition is the key for quick learning. Another thing help us to speed in HINDI learning, when parents are bringing student to the class just remind them what did they do in last class.

Quizzes: To make class interesting we will have some small quizzes with rewards.

Third Level of HINDI CLASS:

Our primary objective is to begin speaking in **Hindi** as soon as possible.

We will do revision of all earlier lessons. Some Assignments will be given.

Since language learning depends on the continuous accumulation of vocabulary and grammar, we will like to repeat old knowledge of Hindi.

Students will start reading Stories and poems.

Students will translate from English to Hindi.

Students will participate in filling the blanks and make sentences.

Grammar, Reading and Writing:

This component of the course,
the fundamentals of Hindi grammar and basic vocabulary.

Quizzes and Dictations:

We will have short Quiz and Dictations from each lesson time to time.

Fourth and Final Level of HINDI CLASS:

Students will start from basic skills and revise the third level of Hindi class curriculum. They will practice and sharpen their skills.

Students will gain command on speaking, reading and writing.

Students will be reading books, stories and talking all in Hindi and Participating in Hindi discussion.

Students will be telling stories from their daily experience.
